When constructed, the new park will be **twice** the size of Fountain City Park, with the potential of becoming **four times** its size.

This park will be the hub to the spokes of greenways extending out to connect our neighborhoods, our schools, our library, our parks and our shopping centers.

This park will bring **economic value to Halls**. It will increase real estate values and quality of life for the connected residences. Businesses rank parks and open space a top priority when looking to locate.

We must buy it now. While only a small portion of the land is developable, developers are interested. And the site is only suitable for a small strip shopping center – do we need more of the same for Halls?

This project will only succeed with full support of the Halls community. **There are no capital dollars in Knox County's budget at this time for this project**. However, working through the Legacy Parks Foundation, if the community raises the dollars to secure the land, Knox County will commit to build the park.

An offer to purchase the property has been made by Legacy Parks Foundation on behalf of the Halls community.

We have only six months to raise \$575,000 to purchase the property.
